

How to Make MUCH BETTER Flash Cards

Instead of just putting the definition on the back, try this:

Definition from the book	<i>Paraphrase the definition</i> (When you paraphrase, you're helping yourself comprehend the information, not just try to remember it.)
Example (your own or from the book)	Picture to help you remember (Visual memory is a powerful study tool. If you can link a concept to a picture, you may remember it better.)

Some other things you could substitute for examples or pictures:

The "anti-example" – consider what this idea/thing is NOT (helpful for some topics, like A&P)

A question

A note about a related concept

Try using larger note-cards.

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
